

It is designed for areas with heavy foot and moderate wheel traffic and can be installed from 3/16 to 1/4 inch thick. Temper-Crete RT is thermal shock resistant, does not require a topcoat, and is ideal for food and beverage industries, manufacturing, storage, and warehouses.



Temper-Crete RTC System builds upon the basic RT system and features an optional integral colored urethane cement base, a decorative color chip broadcast using TC-60 Color Chips, and is sealed with EC-95G Gloss Polyurethane Topcoat. Temper-Crete RTC is ideal for use in laboratories, pharmaceutical spaces, retail, classrooms, hallways, and lobbies.

Temper-Crete RTQ System adds an optional integral colored urethane cement base, a decorative quartz sand broadcast using TC-65 Quartz Sand, and is sealed with EC-36 100% Solids Epoxy and EC-95G. Temper-Crete RTQ offers a decorative and slip-resistant finish that is ideal for use in kitchens, restrooms, veterinary offices, and kennels.
